Suitable for permaculture retreats, survival courses, leadership courses, school camps if you want a wild bush, river and waterfall experience.

We have drumming circle, birds, medicinal plants fires at night and fun learning about nature and farming. It's an experience not to be missed in this lifetime. It is safe and a real treat on many levels.

About us

Lebombo Mountain Village is a self-sustainable food forest, non-racial, nonsexist, and free from religious bias and off the grid conscious community, situated in a tribal authority in South Africa.

Our dream is to create a parallel grid, the same as we currently live in, as we have realized that all our effort and taxes are not contributing to anything that serves us as individuals or humanity at large.

It is our belief that all we need to do is link with other like-minded individuals who have similar philosophies of life and make ourselves known so that others may join a better system. The old system will then become contracted or become redundant,

This project at Lebombo Mountain Village is for off the grid sustainable living based on best practice farming techniques. It incorporates biodynamic techniques and permaculture design. We are part of a bigger picture. We work hand in hand with a local chief and headman to produce healthy organic fruit and vegetables.

School Retreats

Education trips for schools are a valuable way of enhancing classroom-based learning with experiential learning in a natural environment. Lebombo is a treasure chest, particular for Geography, History and Human and Social Science teachers.

Dormitory accommodation is suitable for both pupils and group leaders. Separate sleeping accommodation allows privacy for teachers and leaders while the dormitory ensures that pupils can be monitored while they enjoy the company of their friends and peers.

The range of activities include: feeding the animals, hiking to the waterfall, collecting your meal from the garden, swimming in the river, bonfires and star gazing.

Children will also be able to enjoy identify the local fauna and flora. Books of local birds are supplied and we encourage students to identify as many as possible. We will also take them through milking a cow and making cheese and butter from it.

Travel on the N12 to Witbank which becomes the N4. After the Alzu garage turn right to Carolina. Go through Carolina over the railway line and then straight to Badplaas. After Badplaas turn right to Lochiel and Elukwatini. Go straight don't go to Lochiel. Be careful there are 2 humps!

Go straight through Elukwatini and then follow the tar road. It will become dust. There are a 4 humps! Before it turns to tar again. Turn right towards the Genesis trail and the Oeshoek boarder. There will be 4 rondavels on the right hand side. If you get onto a good tarred road again you have gone too far. You will have passed Mooi Plaas. Go 6.9 kms when you get to a big bridge you are nearly there. Turn right towards the Vlakplaas clinic at the big tree. On your right there is a pink shop. Go straight through the village with the pink house on to your right. Call me unless you have a bakkie. Go over 3 rivers. You will then see our place.

If you start going up towards Oeshoek you have gone too far. Call me when you turn right at the rondavels. It's 350 kms from Jhb on excellent roads.
